→ DST Golf is on a mission: to get players into the proper position at impact in the simplest way possible. The DST Compressor Wedge and 8-iron feature Delayed Strike Technology (DST), a name for a curved shaft and ultra-wide sole designed to replicate the angle a club and shaft are meant to take at impact. When you swing a Compressor, the hands are leading the clubhead into and through the hitting zone. The clubs help you control the clubhead and (as their name suggests) compress the ball, two of the keys to proper ball-striking as prescribed by DST founder and former European Challenge tour player Bertie Cordle.
