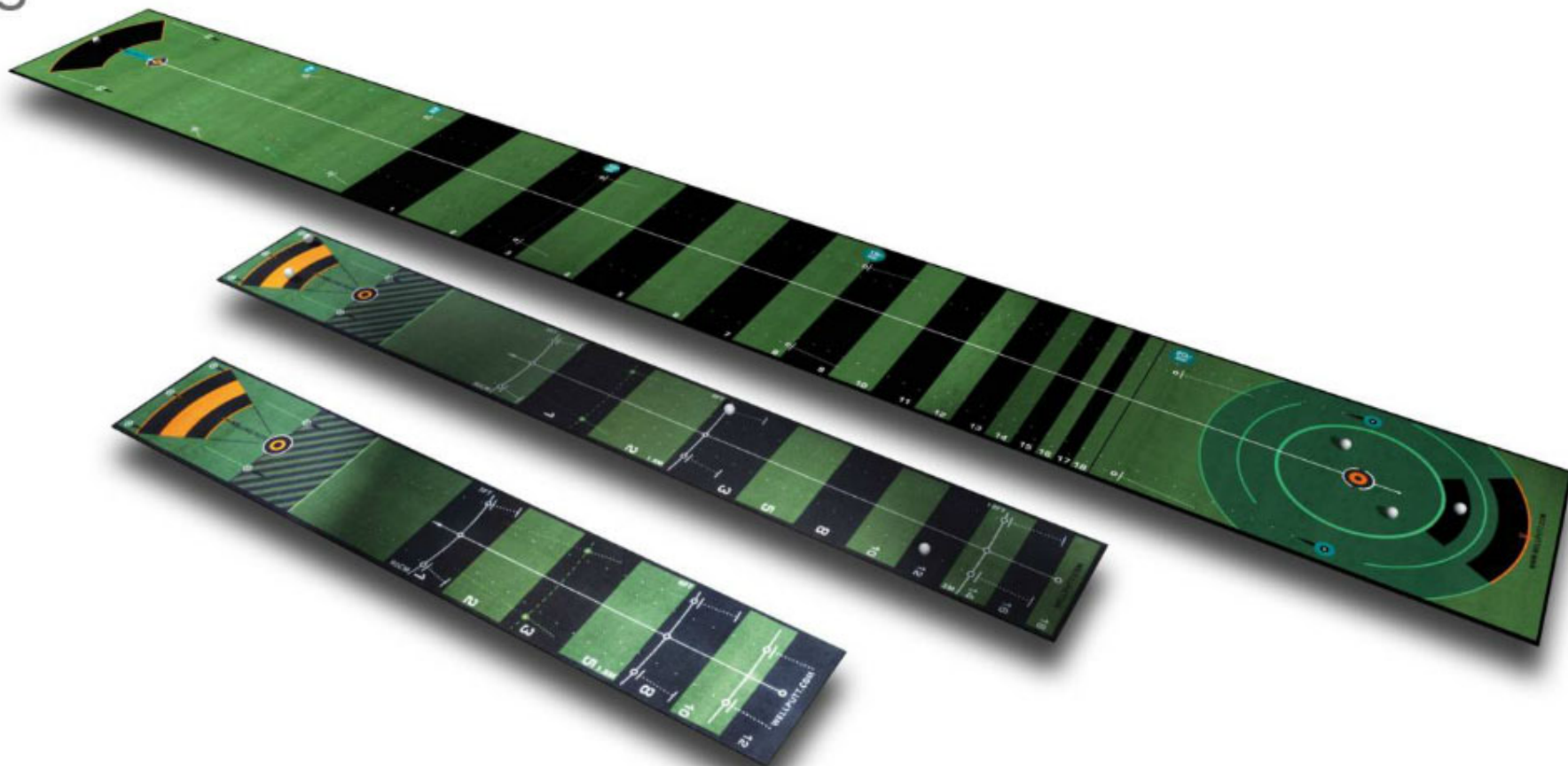

DST Compressor

(dstgolf.com)

This training club has a curved shaft that replicates the shape of a normal shaft under load and helps a golfer understand what lag feels like in the downswing. The goal is to emphasize solid contact and compression. Directional lines on the clubhead and hosel help a golfer achieve the proper position at address and impact. Cost: \$99.99 for a wedge or 8-iron version.



Welling-Putt putting mat

At the PGA Merchandise Show, many golfers were fascinated with this putting mat from French company Wellputt. Why? Because the longest version measures 26 feet, 4 inches in length. Most putting mats are much shorter. Putts appear to roll smoothly on this one, which can be used indoors or outdoors. Different lengths are clearly marked on the mat. It also is available in 13- and 10-foot lengths. Cost of the 26.4-foot mat: \$499.
